SCHOOL POLICY

Ireton Christian School has been established and maintained by an association of parents who believe that it is their duty as Christians to provide Christian Education for their children and believing this can best be accomplished by concerted action, are committed to Christian training for their children in keeping with the teachings of the Holy Word of God.

STATEMENT OF BELIEFS AND PURPOSES

- 1) We believe that God exists in three persons; namely, God the Father who is the Creator and sustainer of the universe; Jesus Christ, the Father's only begotten Son, who was sent into this world to save sinners who believe in Him and who now rules as King of the holy catholic church; and the Holy Spirit who was sent as the Christian's comforter, sanctifier, and guide.
- 2) We believe that the Holy Bible is the only infallible and inspired Word of God and that it must be taught and used as the guide for the Christian's life, conduct, and education.
- 3) We believe that the Word of God requires Christian parents to make every effort to train their children in the fear and nurture of the Lord and that for this reason the instruction of children in the school as well as in the home must be in keeping with the teachings of the Word of God and we believe that we must educate children so that they will become useful servants of their God in His Kingdom and that they may serve as useful citizens of the society in which they live.
- 4) We believe that the right and responsibility to train children belongs to parents and that our school depends on and belongs to parents. It does not depend on or belong to the Church of the State, but has as its foundation the Unchangeable Word of God, interpreted according to the formulas of Unity of the Reformed Churches.
- 5) We believe we must help our students understand that God summons them to honest worship, moral discipline, and personal holiness and that we must equip them for meaningful service in the Kingdom of God.

PARENTAL AGREEMENT

- 1) It is understood that we are enrolling our child in the Ireton Christian School-primarily because of our earnest desire that our child receive a God-centered education.
- 2) It is understood that our child will be educated in a manner consistent with the beliefs and objectives of the Ireton Christian School.
- 3) It is understood that the parents will support, both prayerfully and financially, the school in its efforts to provide education that is distinctively Christian and they will seek to uphold and maintain the fundamental unity of the home and the school.
- 4) It is understood that the personal conduct of all students must conform to the standards of the school. If disagreement exists, parents will have the opportunity to discuss such matters with the faculty, administration, and the board of trustees.
