Truesdell Oil has joined our voucher program. Vouchers can be found online on the Trip section of the school website. Rebate on propane sales only - 0.02 per gallon for propane only customers and .03 per gallon of propane for customers that purchase propane and refined fuel (diesel and/or gasoline). This works for all delivered propane, including contract gallons. A Voucher **MUST** be mailed with your full amount payment in order to get credit. Truesdell will send the rebate back to school.

Orders need to be in the school office or given to Donna Koopmans by 8:30 AM on order dates in your family envelope.

No late orders will be taken. Do not fax or call orders to my house – money needs to accompany orders or they will not be processed. Please try to remind your child to bring the order to their teacher or the office right away when they get to school, so that orders will not be forgotten or late.
